Bias is a metaphor that names systemic distortions in the social and political arena. The notion of bias also draws on a long history of conceptual commitments with rival and conflicting philosophical provenance. Any attempt to limit the workings of bias within an entangled technical arena must grapple with this confounding legacy. Prof. Dr. Howard Caygill (Kingston University London) will ask if and how effective countermeasures may be devised.
